CAN

> We use "can" to express ability.
> We use "can" to express possibility.
> We use "can" to ask for a favor or permission.
> NEGATIVE: CANNOT / CAN'T

COULD

"Could" is used to express ability in the past.We use "could" to express possibility in the past.NEGATIVE: COULD NOT / COULDN'T

EXAMPLES

> Mark can swim very well. (ability)
> You can fail the driving test. (Possibility)
> Can I go to the toilet? (Permission)
> I couldn't read when I was 1 year old. (Ability)
